

From reduced haulage costs secured by the port's close proximity to the UK's motorway network – the major east-west artery of the M62 is just over 1 mile from the docks – to numerous berths, facilities and specialist terminals, the port offers a comprehensive portfolio encompassing unitised, bulk and general cargoes.

Located on the River Ouse, alongside Capitol Park which is home to major enterprises such as Tesco, Guardian Glass and Drax Energy, this versatile inland port can accommodate vessels with an overall length of 100 m, a beam of 24 m and a maximum draft of 6 m. Facilities are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week by arrangement.

Major names in international trade work closely with ABP to

provide only the best in facilities and service. Goole's multiplicity of cargo operations includes containers, bulks and general cargoes, stimulated by a network of shortsea services reaching out to Northern Europe, Scandinavia and the Baltic. The port has an abundance of modern storage amounting to almost 100,000 sq m. Its efficient handling of dry bulk cargoes encompasses agribulks, cement, construction material, solid fuel, animal feed, timber, biomass, cereals and more. Facilities
